# **2025 CURRICULUM OVERVIEW**

### YEAR 3—TERM 2

### **ENGLISH**

Students will explore animal characters from a range of illustrated stories, and the character traits they portray; loyalty, kindness, bravery. They will then choose their favourite character to be the class mascot.

Students will create, rehearse and deliver a persuasive speech in order to express their opinion and persuade their peers of why a character they have chosen from a book should be the selected as the class mascot. Students will also read, view and comprehend a range of texts.

### **MATHEMATICS**

Students will learn to partition, rearrange and regroup numbers to assist them with solving addition, subtraction and multiplication problems involving two- and three-digit numbers. They will also make estimates to determine the reasonableness of calculations.

Students will also use mathematical modelling to solve practical problems involving twos, fives and tens multiplication facts. During this term students will estimate, compare and measure the duration of events using formal units of time such as seconds, minutes and hours.

### SCIENCE

Students will conduct an investigation into how liquids and solids change state when heat is added or taken away.

They will make a prediction, record observations and suggest reasons for their findings. Students describe how safety and fairness were considered.

### **TECHNOLOGY**

Students will demonstrate an understanding of technology and the sustainable uses of resources by planning, designing and creating a useful item for the home or classroom from repurposed materials.

### **THE ARTS**

Students will be studying Media Arts. Using the elements of media, students will create a persuasive PowerPoint to convince an audience of their opinion, connecting with their unit in English. They will also discuss similarities and differences between a variety of media artworks, as well as the importance of copyright.

#### Health: Healthy relationships

Students will continue to identify what healthy relationships look like, within themselves, friendships, family and their community. They will continue investigating strategies for dealing with change and how to identify community members to help their wellbeing and safety.

#### **PE: Athletics**

Students will perform specialised Athletics skills in all athletic track and field events during PE lessons. They will practice and refine skill sequences to improve their upon their initial performance in Shot Put, Sprints and Long Jump.

### HASS (Humanities & Social Sciences)

Students will be focusing on developing their understanding of and skills in the Geography stand.

Students will investigate the natural and human characteristics of Australia and its neighbouring countries in the Asia region. They will label states, territories and capital cities on maps of Australia, other neighbouring countries, and places on world maps.
