Welcome to Ripley Valley State School

We wish all of the new Prep students and their families a very warm welcome to Ripley Valley State School this year. We understand that beginning Prep is a very special time filled with a lot of excitement and perhaps some anxiety as well. The Prep team are here to ensure all students feel safe and secure and are ready to settle in to their learning journey as smoothly as possible.

In the first two weeks of school Prep students have been learning what it is to be a learner at Ripley Valley State School. We have visited important areas of our school and enjoyed getting to know the staff and students in our classrooms and throughout the school.

Meet the teacher – Miss Marcia Slotegraaf (Miss S)

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This is my 13th year as a teacher for education QLD and I have taught in Prep classrooms for 12 of those years. Before beginning my career with Education Queensland, I worked with children from birth to five years in an early education setting for over 10 years. I love teaching Prep and really value the enthusiasm and growth of young students in their first official year of schooling.

Teaching and Learning in Term 1

English and HASS

This term, students will be working on an integrated unit encompassing English and HASS. Students will be exploring and sharing personal thoughts, ideas and experiences with their peers. They will be developing their communication skills through speaking and listening to others and developing comprehension skills through listening and responding to stories. Evidence of their learning will be assessed via retelling a personal experience or event.

Maths

Students will be investigating numbers to 10, including connecting number names, numerals and quantities, subitizing, comparing and ordering collections, and counting to and from 20. Students will also explore patterns, position and movement.

Science

Students will examine different types of weather and how it affects themselves and others. They will select and explain their choices of activities and clothing for different types of weather.

HPE

This term students will be learning about areas that are safe to play in and be active. They will learn about the importance of being physically active and how their bodies respond to different movements. Students will perform fundamental movement skills of running, jumping, hopping and galloping through various games and activities. They will also be participating in perceptual motor skills.

The Arts

The students in Prep will be focusing on Visual Arts and will use a range of methods including lines, shapes, colours, patterns, digital images and materials including paint, paper, crayons, pencils, and play dough to create artwork about themselves. The students will also be developing their Music skills including rhythm, pitch, dynamics, expression and aural skills.

Home Readers

In the coming weeks, we will begin sending home readers home with your child. These are to be used for daily literacy exposure and can be read by your child or read to your child by you, a sibling, or another family member. Your child's teacher will inform you of the process for using and swapping home readers each week. In the meantime, feel free to begin daily reading using your personal book collections, bedtime stories, or library books.

Library Books

Please note that we will visit the library to borrow books every Monday. Library books should be returned on Friday's or Monday mornings, so that students are able to borrow a new book. Students require a waterproof and sealable library bag or folder to keep their borrowed books safe in. These can be purchased from the school uniform shop.

School Canteen – Roo’s Kitchen

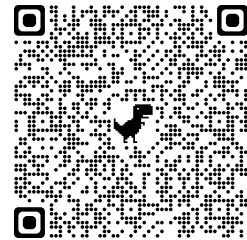

If your child is absent from school and has ordered lunch, you have until 9am on the day to cancel the order alternatively you or a sibling can collect the order. The school is not able to cover the cost for lunches not collected.
